

Privacy Policy Rubber Resources B.V.

Rubber Resources B.V. is dedicated to protecting the confidentiality and privacy of information entrusted to Rubber Resources B.V. and the parent company. As part of this fundamental obligation, Rubber Resources B.V. is committed to the appropriate protection and use of personal data (also referred to as “personal information”).

The company’s intent is to collect only the personal data that is provided to us so that we can offer information and/or services and share information about employment opportunities. Please review this privacy statement ("Privacy Statement") to learn more about how we collect, use, share, protect and process personal data.

1. Collection and use of personal data

1.1 What type of data do we collect

We obtain personal data about you if you choose to share it with us – for example, to contact mailboxes, participate in offers or register for certain services. In some cases, you may have previously provided your personal data to Rubber Resources B.V. (if, for example, you are a former employee or customer or partner).

By registering and/or submitting personal data to Rubber Resources B.V., you are giving your consent to us so that Rubber Resources B.V. may use this data in accordance with this Privacy Policy. Your personal data is not used for other purposes, unless we obtain your permission, or unless otherwise required or permitted by law or professional standards. For example, if you subscribe to our services or participate in any of our offers and provide information about your preferences, we will use this information to personalise your user experience. If you subscribe to receive direct marketing (i.e. newsletters, insights, events etc.) we may use your personal data in order to send you such messaging.

If you send us a resume or curriculum vitae (CV) to apply online for a position at Rubber Resources B.V., we will use the information that you provide to match you with available job opportunities within Rubber Resources B.V.

1.2 Legal grounds to use personal data

Rubber Resources B.V. generally collects only the personal data necessary to fulfil your request. Where additional data is sought, you will be notified of this at the point of collection.

The applicable legislation allows us to process personal data, so long as we have a processing ground under the law to do so. It also requires us to tell you what those grounds are. As a result, when we process your personal data, we will rely on one of the following legal grounds for processing:

- Performance of a contract: this is when the processing of your personal data is necessary in order to perform our obligations under a contract or the intention to enter into a contract;
- Legal obligation: this is when we are required to process your personal data in order to comply with a legal obligation, such as keeping records for tax purposes or providing information to a public body or law enforcement agency;
- Legitimate interests: we may process data about you where it is in our legitimate interest in running a lawful business to do so in order to further that business, so long as it doesn't outweigh your interests; or
- Your consent: we may occasionally ask you for specific permission to process some of your personal data, and we will only process your personal data in this way if you agree to us doing so. You may withdraw your consent at any time by contacting c.bulten@rubber-resources.com.

1.3 Purposes for which your personal data will be processed

We will only process your personal data for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes and we will not process your personal data further in a way that is incompatible with those purposes.

This purpose can be the execution of an engagement, the improvement of your visit on our website or portals, the improvement of our products and services more generally, the offering of services or applications, marketing communications and actions, web personalisation, direct marketing and web analytics among others.

The purpose of each processing of your personal data will be clearly defined in the privacy notice. This privacy notice will be accessible, for example, on a website or portal, on an application, in an electronic newsletter and all other communications.

1.4 Automatic collection of personal data

In some instances, Rubber Resources B.V. and its service providers use cookies, web beacons and other technologies to automatically collect certain types of information when you visit us online, as well as through emails that we may exchange. The collection of this information allows us to customise your online experience, improve the performance, usability and effectiveness of Rubber Resources B.V. and its subsidiaries' online presence, and to measure the effectiveness of our marketing activities.

1.4.1 IP addresses

An IP address is a number assigned to your computer or Internet enabled device whenever you access the Internet. It allows computers and servers to recognise and communicate with one another. IP addresses from which visitors appear to originate may be recorded for IT security and system diagnostic purposes. This information may also be used in aggregate form to conduct website trend and performance analysis. In Google Analytics, we have changed the settings in such a way that it is not possible to trace any IP address in the Analytics tools.

1.4.2 Cookies

In order to be able to launch and maintain www.rubber-resources.com we make use of cookies. A cookie is a small file containing a string of characters that is sent to your computer when you visit a website. When you visit the website again, the cookie allows the website to recognize your browser. Cookies may store user preferences and other information.

Rubber Resources B.V. places only cookies that are necessary for the functionality of the website, such as log-in or registration. The use of cookies is important for the optimum functionality of the website, but also cookies of which the effect is not immediately noticed - such as Google Analytics - are important. Without the anonymous input of the visitors we do not have an idea of the use of the website and how we can improve and optimise it. In case you do not want that cookies are placed you can deactivate them easily through your browser.

Below you will find an explanation of the cookies used on www.rubber-resources.com.

Google Analytics

Google Analytics collects anonymous data about the surf behaviour on www.rubber-resources.com. Your IP- address is explicitly not released. In this way we see how the visitors use the website. We use this data to make informed decisions about the set up and functionality of our website as well as its optimisation. The collected information is saved by Google on servers in the United States. Google submits this information also to advertisers to get insights into the effectiveness of their campaigns. Google might be obliged to submit this information to third parties in case there are legal grounds for it. We have no influence on this matter. We have not granted Google approval to use this information for other purposes. For more information please read the Privacy Policy of Google.

Core functions

These are cookies that are strictly necessary for the functioning of the website. Without these cookies certain parts of the website cannot be used. These are cookies for registering, logging in and sending information on www.rubber-resources.com.

Social media buttons

In order to be able to promote and share pages on LinkedIn there is a social media button placed on www.rubber-resources.com. This button is pieces of codes of this social media site and make use of cookies. This cookie remembers that you are logged in to avoid repetitive log-in. In order to see how these codes of information are used please refer to the privacy policy of LinkedIn.

Embedded content

In the news pages on www.rubber-resources.com content hosted on other pages might be used, for example slide share presentations and YouTube video's. In a way similar to the social media buttons would these sites make use of cookies. In order to see how these codes of information are used please refer to the privacy policies of the respective sites and services. We do not have any influence on that.

How to disable cookies?

If you would like to block cookies, you can do so for the browser you use.

When you disable cookies, remember that some graphics may not appear correctly, or that you may be unable to use certain applications or online services.

If you wish to delete the placed cookies, you may do so by clearing your browser's cookies.

Types of Cookies

“Session” Cookies are stored in the device’s memory only during a user's browsing session and are automatically deleted from the user's device when the browser is closed.

“Persistent” Cookies are stored on the user's device and are not deleted when the browser is closed, unless deleted by you. Permanent cookies can retain user preferences for a particular website, allowing those preferences to be used in future browsing sessions.

Below is a list of the types of cookies used on our website:

Other third party tools and widgets may be used on our individual webpages to provide additional functionality. Use of these tools or widgets may place a cookie on your device to make their service easier to use, and ensure your interaction is displayed on our webpages properly.

Cookies by themselves do not tell us your email address or otherwise identify you personally. In our analytical reports, we may obtain other identifiers excluding IP addresses, but this is for the purpose of identifying the number of unique visitors to our website and geographic origin of visitor trends, and not to identify individual visitors. By navigating on our website or entering you login details to access areas reserved for registered users, you agree that we can place these cookies on your computer or Internet enabled device.

1.4.3 Third Parties

Google Analytics

We rely on Google Analytics, a service provided by Google, Inc. (“Google”), to analyse your use of the website. The information generated by Google Analytics is subject to Google’s privacy policy and will be transferred to and stored by Google on servers in the USA. Prior to the transfer, it will be anonymised by removing the last octet of your IP address. Google will then process it on our behalf in order to evaluate your use of the website, to compile reports on website activity and to provide other services related to Internet usage. Google will not link your IP address with any other data held by Google. You may refuse the use of cookies for the aforesaid purposes by setting your browser accordingly; however, in that case, you may not be able to use the full functionality of the website. You may further opt-out of the collection of your usage data (including your IP address) and its processing by downloading and installing the add-on for your current web browser at <http://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout?hl=en>.

1.4.4 Location-based tools

Rubber Resources B.V. may collect and use the geographical location of your computer or mobile device. This location data is collected for the purpose of providing you with information regarding services which we believe may be of interest to you based on your geographic location, and to improve our location-based communications and services.

1.5 Social media widgets and applications

Rubber Resources B.V. website may include functionality to enable sharing via third party social media applications, such as LinkedIn widgets. This social media application may collect and use information regarding your use of the website of Rubber Resources B.V. Any personal data that you provide via such social media applications may be collected and used by other members of that social media application and such interactions are governed by the privacy policies of the companies that provide the application. We do not have control over, or responsibility for, those companies or their use of your information. In addition, Rubber Resources B.V. website may host blogs and other applications or services (collectively "social media features"). The purpose of social media features is to facilitate the sharing of knowledge and content. Any personal data that you provide on any Rubber Resources B.V. social media feature may be shared with other users of that social media feature (unless otherwise stated at the point of collection), over whom we may have limited or no control.

1.6 Children

Rubber Resources B.V. understands the importance of protecting children's privacy, especially in an online environment. In particular, our sites are not intentionally designed for or directed at children.

2. Sharing and transfer of personal data

We do not share personal data with unaffiliated third parties, except as necessary for our legitimate professional and business needs, to carry out your requests, and/or as required or permitted by law or professional standards. In addition, Rubber Resources B.V. may transfer certain personal data across geographical borders to our parent company or outside companies working with us or on our behalf. Rubber Resources B.V. may also store personal data in a jurisdiction other than where you are based. Transfer of personal data by Rubber Resources B.V. takes place in accordance with the applicable European Union data protection legislation.

- Rubber Resources B.V. may also disclose personal data to our service providers: Rubber Resources B.V. works with reputable partners, service providers or agencies so they can process your personal data on our behalf. Rubber Resources B.V. will only transfer personal data to them when they meet our strict standards on the processing of data and security. We only share personal data that allows them to provide their services.
- Audits: disclosures of personal data may also be needed for data privacy or security audits and/or to investigate or respond to a complaint or security threat.

In addition, Rubber Resources B.V. may transfer certain personal data outside of the EEA to outside companies working with us or on our behalf for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy. Rubber Resources B.V. may also store personal data outside of the EEA. If we do this your personal data will continue to be protected by means of contracts we have in place with those organisations outside the EEA, which are in a form approved by the European Commission. By providing personal data online, visitors are consenting to this transfer and/or storage of their personal data across borders. Rubber Resources B.V. will not transfer the personal data you provide to any third parties for their own direct marketing use.

3. Choices

In general, you are not required to submit any personal data to Rubber Resources B.V., but we may require you to provide certain personal data in order for you to receive additional information about our services and events. Rubber Resources B.V. may also ask for your permission for certain uses of your personal data, and you can agree to or decline those uses. If you opt-in for particular services or communications, such as an e-newsletter, you will be able to unsubscribe at any time by following the instructions included in each communication. If you decide to unsubscribe from a service or communication, we will try to remove your information promptly, although we may require additional information before we can process your request.

As described in "Cookies" above, if you wish to prevent cookies from tracking you as you navigate our sites, you can reset your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. Note, however, that some portions of our sites may not work properly if you elect to refuse cookies.

4. Your rights

If you have submitted personal data to Rubber Resources B.V., you have the following rights:

- Access and correction: you have the right to access to that data. This is sometimes called a 'Subject Access Request'. If we agree that we are obliged to provide personal data to you, we will provide it to you free of charge. Before providing personal data to you, we may ask for proof of identity and sufficient information about your interactions with us that we can locate your personal data. If the information we hold about you is incorrect, you may ask us to correct any inaccuracies in the personal data.
- Object to processing: you have the right to object to us processing your personal data if we are not entitled to use it any more, to have your data deleted if we are keeping it too long or have its processing restricted in certain circumstances.
- Right to restriction of processing: you have the right to request a restriction on the processing of your personal data (for example, while the accuracy of your personal data is being checked).
- Right to erasure: you have the right to the erasure of any data concerning you (except in some cases, for example, to prove a transaction or when required by law).
- Right to data portability: under certain conditions, you have the right to receive your personal data, which you have provided to us, in a commonly used, structured machine readable format and to transmit your personal data to any third party of your choice.

You can make a request or exercise these rights by contacting Rubber Resources B.V. at c.bulten@rubber-resources.com and we will make all reasonable and practical efforts to comply with your request, as long as it is consistent with applicable law and professional standards.

5. Data security and integrity

Rubber Resources B.V. has reasonable security policies and procedures in place to protect personal data from unauthorized loss, misuse, alteration, or destruction. Despite Rubber Resources B.V.'s best efforts, however, security cannot be absolutely guaranteed against all threats. To the best of our ability, access to your personal data is limited to those who have a need to know. Those individuals who have access to the personal data are required to maintain the confidentiality of such information. We also make reasonable efforts to retain personal data only for so long as the data is necessary to comply with an individual's request or with the applicable legislation.

6. Links to other sites

Please be aware that Rubber Resources B.V. website may contain links to other sites, including sites maintained by the parent company that are not governed by this Privacy Policy but by other privacy statements that may differ somewhat. We encourage users to review the privacy statements of each website visited before disclosing any personal data.

By visiting any website managed by Rubber Resources B.V. and then navigating to the parent company website, you agree to the use of your personal data in accordance with the privacy statements of the Rubber Resources B.V. website you are visiting.

7. Changes to this Policy

Rubber Resources B.V. may modify this Privacy Policy from time to time to reflect our current privacy practices. When we make changes to this Policy, we will revise the "updated" date at the top of this page. We encourage you to periodically review this Privacy Policy to be informed about how Rubber Resources B.V. is protecting your data.

If we make any significant changes in the way we treat your personal data we will make this clear via our website.
